Recognition of Coaching Competency supporting documents:

The application must contain supporting evidence.

All supporting documents must be translated into English and must be originals or certified true copies, signed or initialed where appropriate.

1. Qualification

- a. Copy of certificate applying for recognition. Certificates must be current - The date of issue must be on the certificate. If there is no date on the certificate, a letter must be provided from the federation who conducted the course, confirming the date on which the certificate was issued.
- b. An outline of the course content.
- c. Total course hours (both Practical and Theory).
- d. Assessment methods.
- e. An official written acknowledgment of your attendance and results from the course organiser and/or authorising body.

2. Education and Training

- a. Documents that demonstrate the formal coaching education that the applicant has undertaken (for example, certificates, qualifications, licenses, testimonials)
- 3. Coaching-related Experience
 - a. Resume of coaching experience and positions held. This must include references.
 - b. Any statements, references or articles regarding former employment or community involvement.
 - c. Relevant coaching samples (for example, copies of training programs, or coaching assessment tools which the applicant has developed and implemented)
 - d. Coaching logbook
 - e. Coaching Session Delivery (Training)
 - f. Match Day Coaching (In Competition)
 - g. Letters of Recommendation
- 4. Working with Children Check.
- 5. Must obtain an International Criminal History Check
